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Berlin Latin Lexicon and LatMor: A large-coverage finite-state open-source morphology for Latin

Despite the many Latin corpora, lexica and tools that have become available in electronic form in the last years and that offer free access to a humanist looking at them, we still lack the opportunity to work with the data themselves: Downloading them, processing them with our computers, and distributing the results to the public at large without any undue restrictions.

The LatMor morphology, in addition to providing state of the art transducer technology to the existing collection of lemmatizers, is available as open source to any researcher or interested citizen to be used or adapted to his or her needs. We give an overview of its use and of the resources it is built upon.
